Ultimi grappoli langhe rosso

Grape-varieties: Barbera and Nebbiolo

Vineyard location: La Morra

Vines per hectare: c. 5000

Planting distance: 2,30 x 0,90 m

Altitude: 250 metres a.s.l.

Position: facing south-west

Training system: guyot

Age of vines: 10-40 years

Yield (grapes per hectare): 5000 kg.

Soil: calcareous blue marl

Harvest period: November

Wine-making procedure: traditional in heat-controlled tanks

Maturing: 18 months in oak barrels; 12 months in the bottle

Tasting properties: deep, bright ruby red, with purplish highlights; rich bouquet of plums, fruit of the forest, and fleshy, ripe cherries. Thick fruit in the mouth, with delicate tannins backing a powerful body; wonderful finish.

Excellent with big dishes: red meat, mature and medium-mature cheeses.



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
