Soil: calcareous blue marl

Harvest period: end of September

Wine-making procedure: traditional in heat-controlled tanks

Maturing: 6 months in stainless steel; 6 months in the bottle

Tasting properties: bright ruby-red; very vinous, intense, fresh nose showing a range of fresh fruit and flowers; rich, luscious taste that's smooth and medium-bodied; excellent as an everyday wine.
