LANGHE ROSSO DOC Ballarin

Grape varietal: Barbera, Nebbiolo and Cabernet

Vineyard of origin: La Morra

Planting layout: 2.30 x 0.90 m

Altitude: 250 metres a.s.l.

Exposure: south-west

Vine training technique: guyot

Age of vines: 10-40 years

Yield per hectare: 60 quintals of grapes/ha

Soil: limestone – blue marlstone

Harvest: October

Vinification: traditional in temperature controlled tanks

Ageing: 18 months in barriques

Further ageing: 6 months in the bottle

Sensory characteristics: Intense and bright ruby red colour, rich bouquet featuring a combination of herbal and fruity scents. Good balance of Cabernet and the grapes of Langhe. The palate is balanced and displays very delicate notes of bois. Suited to ageing.



INTERESTING FACTS

This wine is obtained from a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Nebbiolo and Barbera d'Alba.

The grapes are from vineyards in La Morra and Monforte d'Alba and the wine is aged in French barriques.



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
